

New England Conservatory's Jordan Hall **30 Gainsborough Street | Boston, MA 02115**

Parking around the hall is expensive. Inexpensive options are very limited. In some cases, our concerts overlap with events at Symphony Hall, making parking even more challenging. For these reasons, we strongly recommend using public transportation. **Please note that ongoing construction around Jordan Hall has made parking even more limited.**

Using the T:

Take the green line "E" train to the Symphony stop. Walk one block west on Huntington Avenue toward the YMCA. Take a left onto Gainsborough Street. Jordan Hall is immediately on your right, inside the main New England Conservatory building at 30 Gainsborough Street.

or

Take the Orange line to the Mass. Ave stop. Exit at the Gainsborough Street end of the platform (farthest from Mass. Ave). Jordan Hall is diagonally across from the exit.

or

From the southern suburbs, take the Attleboro/Stoughton line of the commuter rail to Ruggles. Walk out to Huntington Avenue and take a right. Gainsborough Street (and Jordan Hall) is about a 10-minute walk east.

Parking:

Gainsborough Garage is located at 10 Gainsborough Street, just across St. Botolph Street from Jordan Hall. From Copley: West on Huntington Avenue (Rte. 9). Cross Massachusetts Avenue (pass Symphony Hall on your right). Left at the next traffic light onto Gainsborough Street. The garage is straight ahead on the right.
\$25.00 event parking - Open 24 hours/day (617) 266-7260

Westland Avenue Garage at the Church Park Apartments is located at 35 Westland Avenue, above Whole Foods Market. From Copley: West on Huntington Avenue (Rte. 9). Turn right onto Massachusetts Avenue. Take the 1st left onto Westland Avenue. The parking garage will be on the right.
\$25.00 (rate for 1.5-10 hours) - Open until midnight (617) 437-1577

Renaissance Park Garage is located at 835 Columbus Avenue at Melnea Cass Boulevard. This is about a 10-minute walk from Jordan Hall, but is the most inexpensive garage in the area. From Copley: West on Huntington Avenue. Turn left onto Massachusetts Avenue. Turn right onto Columbus Avenue. To walk to Jordan Hall, walk East on Columbus toward Mass. Ave. Turn left onto Camden Street and cross over MBTA overpass. Jordan Hall is diagonally across from other side of the overpass.
\$6.00 weekend parking (begins Friday after 6:00pm) – Open until midnight (617) 373-2366

Very limited **street parking** is available on Gainsborough Street, Huntington Avenue, and St. Stephen Street. Meters are free after 6:00pm and on Sundays.

City designated **handicapped parking** spaces are located on Huntington Avenue (two spaces next to the 290 Huntington Avenue entrance of NEC and two spaces outside the Cohen entrance to Symphony Hall) and St. Stephen Street (one space next to the Symphony Hall stage door). Because of the large number of arts organizations operating in the immediate area, these spaces may not be readily available to Jordan Hall patrons.

Jordan Hall's **handicap accessible entrance** is located on Gainsborough Street just to the left of the main steps. This entrance has a street level elevator that opens into the Hall's main corridor, just in front of the will call table.
